Who are we?

The Association Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) was founded in 1890 to perpetuate the memory of those who fought for pro-independence in the American War of Independence. During these 130 years we have maintained the established guidelines of a non-political, non-profit association, with three objectives: to preserve our history, promote education and encourage patriotism. We currently have 193,000 members worldwide with one common denominator: we all have a patriot in our family tree who fought or helped in the War of Independence.

It is our wish to seek out Spanish descendants of those soldiers and citizens who fought or helped in our War of Independence.

The inclusion of the United States among the countries invited to participate in the commemoration of the 5th Centenary of the Magellan-Elcano Expedition may be surprising, given that during their voyage, the ships of that navy never touched port in any US territory. The reason for the American involvement is the fact that we are the Administrators of the Guam territory since the Spanish-American War in 1898, an island discovered by the Magellan-Elcano expedition during its voyage in the Pacific Ocean.

The CEU Elcano International Chair. First Round-the-World Tour was created through an agreement signed by the Spanish Navy and the CEU San Pablo University as part of the celebrations for the 5th Centenary of the expedition of the first round-the-world tour by Fernando de Magallanes and Juan Sebastián Elcano (1519-1522).

The CEU Cardenal Herrera University, the CEU Abat Oliba University and the CEU San Pablo Andalucía Foundation complete the list of the Chair's promoters.

It is an inter-university, international Chair. It is a proposal that is open to the public, to which an attempt will be made to transmit the consequences that the expedition had for the cultural and geographical evolution of humanity.

Created as part of the 5th Centenary with the sponsorship from Mapfre, it aims to be a reference in the studies around the Magellan-Elcano expedition, a permanent forum for study, reflection and knowledge transfer that will go beyond the temporal space of the Centenary.

Rules

- 1. Participants** Spanish university students and students from universities that have signed up to the objectives of the CEU Elcano International Chair.First Round-the-World Tour.
- 2. Subject of the 2020-21 call:** The journey of the training ship Juan Sebastian Elcano: following the steps of the first circumnavigation.
- 3. Organisation:** Daughters of the American Revolution Spain Chapter and CEU Elcano International Chair.First Round-the-World Tour.
- 4. How to take part?** In order to enter the competition, an original work must be submitted in PDF format in Spanish or English and signed with a pseudonym. The text must be a maximum of 1500 words, in Times New Roman or Calibri size 12 double-spaced font. The work should include: a first page with the title "The Journey of the School Ship Juan Sebastian Elcano: Following the Steps of the First Circumnavigation," to which a subtitle may be added to reflect the particular focus of the paper. A summary in Spanish and English of up to 200 words should also be added. The work must be original, with no plagiarism, and if other material is used, its source must be cited. The contestants undertake, in the event of being awarded a prize, to send the text in Word format so it can be processed for publication on the website of the organising institutions.
- 5. Presentation of originals Deadline for submission:** Friday 26 March 2021. Authors must send two PDF files to the email ceu-elcano@ceu.es. A file with the signed paper under a pseudonym chosen by the author and another file with the pseudonym, the author's name and surname, address, telephone number, e-mail and university. The Prize secretariat will include the personal data in a sealed envelope, which will not be disclosed until the judgement is made.
- 6. Jury's verdict** This will be made public on 26 April.
- 7. Prizes.** A first prize of €400 and a runner-up prize of €100 will be awarded. Mentions may be awarded if the jury deems this appropriate. The prizes may be declared without a winner.
- 8. Jury** This shall be made up of 4 members: 2 on behalf of the association Daughters of the American Revolution and 2 on behalf of the CEU Elcano International Chair.First Round-the-World Tour.
- 9.** The winners authorise the dissemination of their names and photographs of the awards ceremony, both on social networks and in other media.
- 10.** The competition rules are published on the websites of the organising institutions.
- 11.** Participation in the Competition implies, in itself, the knowledge and acceptance of the full content of these rules.
